On the twenty-third day of March two thousand and twenty-two, at 12:00 hours, the jury nominated by the CCMAR board of Directors on 27/01/2022, met by video conference, for the meeting 2 of the call Ref. CCMAR/BPD/01/2022. The meeting was held for the award of a Research Fellowship (Post Doctoral Fellowship) through the project with reference PTDC/BIA-CBI/6515/2020, named as “The Paris Agreement and the global redistribution of marine biodiversity, Reference PTDC/BIA-CBI/6515/2020 funded by Fundação para a Ciência e a Tecnologia, I.P. /MCTES through national funds (PIDDAC).The nominated jury was composed by Dr. Jorge Assis, coordinator of the project and researcher at UALG and CCMAR (president of the jury), Professor Ester Serrão, Professor at UALG and group leader at CCMAR (member), and Dr. João Neiva, researcher at UALG and CCMAR (member), and had the following agenda items: admission and evaluation of applications admitted to the fellowship CCMAR/BPD/01/2022.

9 applications were received for the position:

III - Exclusion of applications

The jury analysed the applications, considering the mandatory requirements and documents, and decided to exclude 9 candidates (Table 1), for the following reasons:

Tamer Amr Abdelaziz, Sara Albuixech Martí and Yuri Costa did not provide a copy of the acknowledgement of the request for recognition of the Doctoral degree by a Portuguese Public Higher Education Institution or by DGES or the acknowledgement of the request of the Doctoral degree certificate from a Portuguese Higher Education Institution.

Ander Urrutia Garcia did not provide the declaration of honour, available from the application platform, for applicants that at the time of application cannot provide a copy of the doctoral certificate (if awarded

by a Portuguese Higher Education Institution) or of the certificate of recognition of the doctoral degree (if the degree was awarded by a foreign University). Ander Urrutia Garcia did not also provide a copy of the acknowledgement of the request for recognition of the Doctoral degree by a Portuguese Public Higher Education Institution or by DGES or the acknowledgement of the request of the Doctoral degree certificate from a Portuguese Higher Education Institution.

Eudriano Florencio dos Santos Costa obtained a Doctoral Degree more than three years after to the date of submission of the application.

Nurçin Killi and Vaitheeswaran Thiruvengadam obtained a Doctoral Degree more than three years after to the date of submission of the application. Nurçin Killi and Vaitheeswaran Thiruvengadam did not also provide a copy of the acknowledgement of the request for recognition of the Doctoral degree by a Portuguese Public Higher Education Institution or by DGES or the acknowledgement of the request of the Doctoral degree certificate from a Portuguese Higher Education Institution.

Renata Martins Pacheco holds a Doctoral Degree not in Biological Sciences, Environmental Sciences or a related area.

Poonam Mohan holds a Doctoral Degree not in Biological Sciences, Environmental Sciences or a related area. Poonam Mohan did not also provide a copy of the acknowledgement of the request for recognition of the Doctoral degree by a Portuguese Public Higher Education Institution or by DGES or the acknowledgement of the request of the Doctoral degree certificate from a Portuguese Higher Education Institution.


V - Conclusion

No candidate was the admitted to the Research Fellowship (Post Doctoral Fellowship) position.


