On the twenty-fourth day of June two thousand and twenty-two, at 12:00 hours, the jury nominated by the CCMAR board of Directors on 19-05-2022, met by video conference, for the meeting 2 of the call Ref. CCMAR/BPD/19/2022. The meeting was held for the award of a Research Fellowship (Post Doctoral Fellowship) through the project with reference PTDC/BIA-CBI/6515/2020, named as “The Paris Agreement and the global redistribution of marine biodiversity, Reference PTDC/BIA-CBI/6515/2020 funded by Fundação para a Ciência e a Tecnologia, I.P. /MCTES through national funds (PIDDAC). The nominated jury was composed by Dr. Jorge Assis, coordinator of the project and researcher at UALG and CCMAR (president of the jury), Professor Ester Serrão, Professor at UALG and group leader at CCMAR (member), and Dr. João Neiva, researcher at UALG and CCMAR (member), and had the following agenda items: admission and evaluation of applications admitted to the fellowship CCMAR/BPD/19/2022.

II – Candidates

6 applications were received for the position:

III - Exclusion of applications

The jury analysed the applications, considering the mandatory requirements and documents, and decided to exclude 5 candidates (Table 1), for the following reasons:

Beatriz de Sousa Fernandes, Heta Kaarina Mattila, Begum Uzun and Gabriel Martín Rupil did not provide a copy of the Doctoral Certificate (if awarded by a Portuguese Higher Education Institution) or a copy of the certificate of recognition of the Doctoral Degree by a Portuguese Public Higher Education Institution or by DGES – Directorate General for Higher Education (if the degree was awarded by a foreign University) or the complete declaration of honour available from the application platform with the copy of the acknowledgement of the request for recognition of the Doctoral degree by a Portuguese Public Higher Education Institution or by DGES or the acknowledgement of the request of the Doctoral degree certificate from a Portuguese Higher Education Institution.

Oussama Dhaoui does not hold the required Doctoral Degree in Biological Sciences, Environmental Sciences or related area, which needs to be obtained in the three years prior to the date of submission of the application.


