I - Introduction

On the twenty seventh day of July two thousand and twenty-two, at nine hours and thirty minutes, the jury nominated by the CCMAR board of Directors on 08/07/2022, met personally for the meeting 2 of the call Ref. CCMAR/BIC/23/2022. The meeting was held for the award of 08 Research Fellowships (Scientific Initiation Fellowship – BIC) through the research project: “*Verão com Ciência 2022 within the Apoio especial para atividades de investigação científica e tecnológica em unidades de I&D com vista à valorização da capacidade científica e tecnológica e a sua relação com o ensino superior e a sociedade*” funded by the Fundação para a Ciência e Tecnologia, I.P.. The jury included Professor Ana Grenha, Professor at Algarve University (UAlg) and researcher at CCMAR (President of the jury); Professor Dina Simes, Professor at UAlg and researcher at CCMAR (member); Doctor Catarina Oliveira, researcher at UAlg and CCMAR (member); Doctor Luisa Custódio, researcher at CCMAR (member) and Doctor Rita Costa Abecasis, researcher and coordinator of the communication department at CCMAR (member), and had the following agenda items: admission and evaluation of applications admitted to the fellowship CCMAR/BIC/23/2022.

II – Candidates

Thirty-four submissions were received. Candidates André Filipe Miranda Bagão and Bello Muhammad Jamiu submitted made a double submission (Applications 2/11, and 22/27, respectively). The jury considered valid the last application received from each candidate. Overall, thirty-two applications were received for the available positions, as shown in table 1:

2. Motivation to conduct the fellowship working plan – 40%


