I - Introduction

On the 26th day of May two thousand and twenty two, at 16 hours and 30 minutes, the jury nominated by the CCMAR board of Directors on 12/04/2022, met by video conference, for the meeting 2 of the call Ref. CCMAR/BINCGAM/11/2022. The meeting was held for the award of a Research Fellowship for a person with a Master Degree (Bolsa de Investigação não conducente à obtenção de grau académico para pessoa com Mestrado) through the project number 541718158, named as “*LittleFish-STP - São Tome and Príncipe little fish threatened - a big opportunity to unravel this fishery resource in tropical islands.*” funded by the Fundação para a Ciência e a Tecnologia, (FCT) and Rede Aga Khan para o Desenvolvimento. The nominated jury was composed by Doctor Vânia Baptista, coordinator of the project at CCMAR and researcher at CCMAR (president of the jury), Professor Maria Alexandra Anica Teodósio, Vice-Rector at the Algarve University, team leader and researcher at CCMAR, (member) and Doctor Joana Cruz, Professor at Algarve University and researcher at CCMAR (member), and had the following agenda items: admission and evaluation of applications admitted to the fellowship **CCMAR/BINCGAM/11/2022**.

II – Candidates

Ten submissions were performed. Applicant Federica Mongera submitted her application two times. The jury only considered as valid the last application received by this candidate. Overall nine applications were received for the position:

III - Exclusion of applications

The jury analysed the applications, considering the mandatory requirements and documents, and decided to exclude one candidate (Table 1), for the following reasons:

1. Not providing the required declaration of honour for candidates that are unable, at the time of application, to provide a copy of the Master’s degree certificate.

Thus, eight candidates were admitted to the evaluation and ranking phase (Table 2).

According to the documentation sent, on the date of application, the candidate Muhammad Saad Bin Zahid did not provide the required declaration of honour for candidates that are unable to provide a copy of the Master's degree certificate.

IV - Evaluation of applications

The Jury evaluated the application documents of the eligible candidate (Table 2) and applied the classification criteria and weighting factors set out in the vacancy announcement as shown in table 3 below:

Evaluation criteria and respective weighting:

1. CV, including scientific production record (35%)
2. Sampling, samples processing and taxonomic identification of zooplankton, benthic macrofauna, fish, and algae species (35%)
3. Experience in biochemical analyses (10%)
4. Fluency in Portuguese and English, with good communication skills (oral and written) (10%)
5. Statistics and geographic information system (GIS) knowledge (10%)

Note: The final grades in table 3 represent the average of the individual evaluation performed by each member of the jury, presented on a scale from 0 to 20, rounded to the nearest tenth.

Table 4 presents the overall classification in order of rank.

The fellowships will be awarded to the best ranked applicant. Candidate Diana Sofia Nunes Gonçalves has the highest classification (17.6 values; Table 4)

Considering the elements presented, candidate Diana Sofia Nunes Gonçalves meets the conditions for the purposes of eventual selection, so the Jury proposes the ratification of this decision to the CCMAR Board.

The Jury will proceed to the right of prior hearing of the candidates, setting a deadline of 10 working days to claim what they consider to be convenient, whether in relation to scientific or procedural matters.


With no other item on the agenda, the meeting of which these minutes were drawn up was closed, with 3 pages, and annex, which after being read and approved were signed by the members of the jury.
