

## Minute 3

### I - Introduction

On the nineteen day of September two thousand and twenty-two, at 09:00 hours and 30 minutes, the jury nominated by the CCMAR board of Directors on 15/05/2022, met by video conference, for the meeting 3 of the call Ref. CCMAR/BIC/15/2022. The meeting was held for the award of Research Fellowships (Scientific Initiation Fellowship – BIC) through the research project MARAFRICA “A network monitoring, integrating and assessing marine biodiversity data along the west Africa to understand, predict and mitigate climatic / oceanographic changes.” reference no 540316524 funded by Aga Khan, Network for Development and the Portuguese Foundation for Science and Technology, I.P.. 

Thus, we declare under word of honor that we will not evaluate candidates with whom we have a conflict of interest, for what we will require our immediate replacement.




